

HILL 60 FORESHORE IMPROVEMENT WORKS

Community Update – December 2019

The construction works on the riverbank commenced in late October 2019 and are proceeding well and as expected. The following work has been completed or is underway:

- Site establishment, including fencing, laydown and traffic management
- Temporary works-only access to the riverbank
- Vegetation and debris at the base of the slope has been cleared to allow construction
- Earthworks at the base of the slope are underway
- Rock materials have been placed to construct the riverbank protection

These works will progressively continue over the coming months to complete the protection for the base of the slope and riverbank.

Site and traffic management

For the safety of local residents, path users, general public as well as the construction workers, site and traffic management measures have been put in place. These include:

- Construction site fencing
- Diversions for pedestrians and cyclists
- Traffic management signage

During the works, and particularly during delivery of materials, some delays are likely to be experienced. Your patience and respect for the measures put in place to ensure safety for all during this time is much appreciated.
