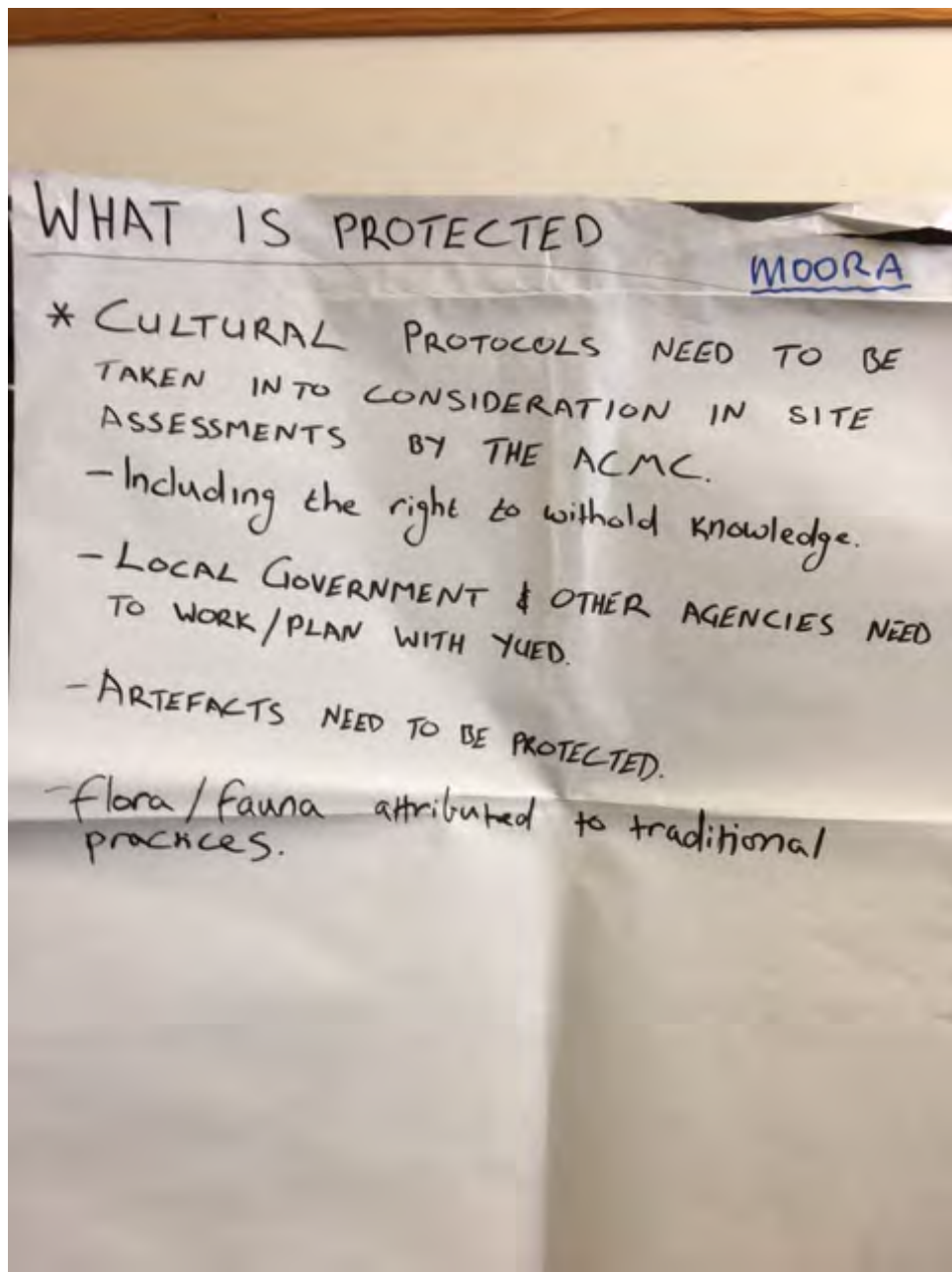

WHAT IS PROTECTED

MOORA

- * CULTURAL PROTOCOLS NEED TO BE TAKEN INTO CONSIDERATION IN SITE ASSESSMENTS BY THE ACMC.
- Including the right to withhold knowledge.
- LOCAL GOVERNMENT & OTHER AGENCIES NEED TO WORK/PLAN WITH YUED.
- ARTEFACTS NEED TO BE PROTECTED.
- flora/fauna attributed to traditional practices.

ANCESTRAL REMAINS

MOORA

- *IF REMAINS ARE BE RE-PATRIATED IT SHOULD BE DONE BY PEOPLE CONNECTED TO THE ANSWER.
- *THE DEPARTMENT TO WORK WITH YUED CONSULTATION GROUP.
- *Specific provisions for Burial Sites.

IMPACTS ON SITES

MOORA

- * THE MINISTER TOGETHER WITH YUED CONSULTATION GROUP.
- * S.18 PROCESS DOES NOT WORK.
- * NO TRANSPARENCY.
- * HIGHER RECOGNITION OF CULTURAL AUTHORITY.
- * INCORPORATE ALL OTHER LEGISLATION (Eg. ~~front~~ ~~forum~~)
- * THE MINISTER'S DECISIONS NEED TO BE TRANSPARENT.
- YUED NEED THE CHANCE TO REPLY.
- * MINISTER ~~SH~~ FOR ABORIGINAL AFFAIRS NEEDS TO BE A STAND ALONE PORTFOLIO TO AVOID A CONFLICT OF INTEREST.

WHAT SITES SHOULD BE PROTECTED?

MOORA

* Significant sites as recognised by respected
recognised & upheld as such by the custodians
of the land, the traditional owners & Aboriginal
People of the area. Including but not exclusively:

- Birthing - Camping - Ceremony
- Hunting - Lookouts - Law - mens
- Song lines - Landscapes - Womens

→ Special Separate Significance - Lore

* Some sites can be grouped together, others are exclusively
seperate (such as birthing)

* Sites that spiritually & culturally significant.

* Intimate detailed knowledge is not required
for a place to be culturally
important & significant.

PENALTIES

* NO

- A complete review of penalties is required.
- Statute of limitations needs to be removed.
- Increase penalties.
- Fines need to go to YUED.
- on the spot fines for offences against individuals.
 - Wardens.
 - Rangers.

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

A ACMC ⇒ WHO & HOW? - structure. MOORA

* Make up of ACMC needs to be reviewed.

- ACMC ^{minister} should meet with people to discuss heritage prior to decision making.

* The economic value of a project should not outway the knowledge of Aboriginal people.

→ Each group needs to be represented on the ACMC

* Form Yued consultation group for minister ^{state} to meet with for decision making - No need for SWALSC.

* Permission must come from YUED people for others to use their information/knowledge.

* YOUNG PEOPLE NEED TO BE BROUGHT INTO THE PROCESS.

WHAT ACTIONS REQUIRE APPROVAL?

MOORA

* MEET WITH YUED CONSULTATION GROUP DURING PRE-PLANNING.

* NEED ~~TO~~ BUFFER ZONES BOUNDARY TO BE WELL DEFINED.

* YUED REPRESENTATIVES AT ALL PHASES OF THE PROPOSAL/PLANNING/WORKS

* LOCAL ^{& NRM} GOVERNMENT NEED TO CONSULT / COMMUNICATE WITH YUED ON ALL PROPOSALS/DEVELOPMENT.

* ELDERS.

* Yued consultation group.

PROTECTED AREAS

MOORA.

- * DECLARED, ^{preserved} ↓ & PROTECTED BY RANGERS.
- * REQUIRE AN AUDIT OF YUED SITES.
- * CROSS REFERENCE WHAT HAS ALREADY BEEN DONE.

HONARARY WARDENS

MOORA

- * IT DID - BUT HAS STOPPED
- * NEED TO BE RE-INSTATED.
 - RESOURCED \$\$
 - AUDITS
 - RECOGNISED Gov.
Public.
 - TRAINING
 - NEEDS TO BE IMPLEMENTED A.S.A.P!
 - NEEDS TO BE SELECTED THROUGH EXPRESSION OF INTEREST - SET CRITERIA
 - BOTH MALE & FEMALE
 - NEEDS ELDERS/MENTOR SUPPORT.
